ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- All programs are five days a week. There are no make up days for classes missed.
- Woodland Montessori Schools tuition is calculated based on a nine month academic year. Tuition may be made in full, in two installments, or in nine monthly installments. Payments are considered late if received on or after the 5th of the month and the school will assess a late fee of \$30.00 which is due immediately.
- A **non refundable application fee of \$75.00** per child is due at the time of application for admission.
- A **non refundable annual enrollment fee of \$350.00** is due upon acceptance when submitting tuition contracts and enrollment agreements.
- A **non refundable materials and activity fee of \$150.00** is due by August 16th. (Tuition payments begin in September)
- A 5% discount on tuition is available for each additional sibling enrolled concurrently.
- If an account has a balance that remains 30 days after the statement due date, the child cannot be allowed to attend school until the account balance is paid in full.
- Alumni Daily visits \$40.00 per day. (Date must be agreed upon in advance with Director) .
- Parents agree to pay a \$10.00 charge for every 5 minutes that a student is left past scheduled pick up time.
- A 30 day notice is required before a child is withdrawn.
- A June Summer Program is available for currently enrolled children of Woodland. June tuition is based on the monthly fee schedule above but is paid separately from the 9 month academic year.
